

Isaiah 53

- v1 Who hath believed our report? and to whom is the arm of the LORD revealed?
- v2a For he shall grow up before him as a tender plant,
- v2b And as a root out of a dry ground: he hath no form nor comeliness;
- v2c And when we shall see him, there is no beauty that we should desire him.
- v3a He is despised and rejected of men; a man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief:
- v3b And we hid as it were our faces from him;
- v3c He was despised, and we esteemed him not.
- v4a Surely he hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows:
- v4b Yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted.
- v5a But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities:
- v5b The chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed.
- v6 All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and the LORD hath laid on him the iniquity of us all.
